#### **General Information**

1. Any sophomore, junior or senior high school student residing in Henry County may compete.
2. Contestants will perform a 1-to-3 minute monologue. Monologue will be timed, and contestants who fall short of or exceed the time limits will be penalized.
3. Monologue must be from a published play written by a Southern author and not from a movie or television program.
4. Selection must be from a play written by a Southern playwright dealing with the southern experience.
5. Monologues with violent behavior patterns, vulgarity, strong language or those that are sexually explicit are inappropriate and unacceptable.
6. Prize money of \$1,000 to the winner, \$500 to the first runner-up, and \$100 to the second runner-up will be awarded. Other prizes will be given to all semi-finalists.
